

ORDINANCE NO. 21-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ISSUE REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS, NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE JEFFERSON STREET ODOT SMALL CITIES GRANT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City of Port Clinton is pursuing the improvement of Jefferson Street pursuant to the ODOT Small Cities Program (the “Project”); and

Whereas, the City must issue, receive and evaluate requests for qualifications from ODOT prequalified engineering companies to perform Construction Management Services during the construction of the Project; and

Whereas, ODOT will reimburse the City 80% of the eligible costs of the construction management services for the Project.

Now, Therefore, be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to issue, receive and evaluate requests for qualifications from ODOT prequalified engineering companies to perform Construction Management Services for the Project, and after reviewing the qualifications to negotiate and to enter into an agreement with one of the engineering firms to perform Construction Management Engineering Services for the ODOT Small Cities Program Jefferson Street Project.

Section 2. The funds necessary to enter into the Construction Management Services agreement are hereby appropriated from the Main Thoroughfare Fund.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and for the further reason that his ordinance is required to be immediately effective so that the City may timely move forward with the Jefferson Street ODOT Small Cities Project to meet the timelines of the

Ohio Department of Transportation, and so that the construction of the Project may be completed this year,

Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
