ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE LAKEVIEW PARK BEACH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, high lake levels at Lakeview Park Beach have caused a large portion of the beach at Lakeview Park to be submerged, allowing wave energy to reach farther onshore; and

WHEREAS, this has resulted in scour and displacement of sand into the nearshore or onto adjacent beach areas; and

WHEREAS, the engineering design plans are complete, and this Council finds and determines that the City should proceed with this project at the earliest possible time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, County of Ottawa, and state of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized to enter into contracts for the reconstruction of the Lakeview Park Beach, not to exceed sixty thousand dollars (60,000.00).

Section 2. The funds necessary to complete this project are hereby appropriated from the Municipal Purposes and Sewer Fund.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in those actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to allow the City to advertise for bids for this project for construction at the earliest possible time, and to take advantage of lower costs of construction;

Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
