A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECORATION OF GRAVES, CONDUCTING MEMORIAL SERVICES AND OTHERWISE ENGAGING IN ACTIVITIES APPROPRIATE FOR THE CELEBRATION OF MEMORIAL DAY 2021

WHEREAS pursuant to R. C. 307.66 the City may appropriate funds for the purpose of helping defray the expenses for the celebration of Memorial Day, and

WHEREAS the City has received an application for such an appropriation from the Alfred G. Dodway Post #113 of the American Legion, to help defray such costs.

Now Therefore Be It RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, County of Ottawa and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City pursuant to R. C. 307.66, which shall be paid to the Alfred G. Dodway Post 113 of the American Legion, to aid in the defraying of expenses of the Memorial Day Celebrations for 2021.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
