ORDINANCE NO. 32-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PORT CLINTON HARBOR PATROL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, County of Ottawa and State of Ohio:

- **Section 1.** That the Chief of Police be and he is hereby authorized and directed to apply for a Marine Patrol Assistance Grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to execute a Marine Patrol Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Port Clinton, with the State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources, thereby enabling the City to receive financial assistance from the State for the operation of a Harbor Patrol Program for the calendar year 2022.
- **Section 2.** That the local share of the funds needed for the operation of the Port Clinton Harbor Patrol is hereby appropriated from General Fund Account No. 101-0433-59370.
- **Section 3.** This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in those actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
