ORDINANCE NO. 36-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE 2 AQUA SCREENS FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT FROM THE FUNDS APPROPRIATED FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City has adopted legislation in Ordinance 23-21 making appropriations for Water Infrastructure and Sewer Infrastructure from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021; and

Whereas, the City is in need of acquiring 2 Aqua Screens for the Wastewater Treatment Plant:

Whereas, the City has researched the required Aqua Screens available to obtain the best price possible for the purchase of the necessary equipment, and

Whereas, it is necessary for the City to spend \$155,000.00 of the funds appropriated to the City for Sewer Infrastructure under the American Rescue Plan Act Fund for the purchase of 2 Aqua Screens for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

Whereas, this Council finds and determines that the City can purchase the supplies it needs using the funds out of the American Rescue Plan Act Fund.

Wherefore, be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, Ohio:

- Section 1. The Director of Safety Service and the City Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with a Supplier for the purchase of 2 Aqua Screens for the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- Section 2. There is hereby appropriated, from unencumbered funds currently on deposit in the American Rescue Plan Act Fund, a sum not to exceed \$155,000.00 to pay the cost of 2 Aqua Screens for the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to provide for the timely purchase of 2 Aqua Screens necessary for the Wastewater

Treatment Plant from the funds appropriated from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021, wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
