ORDINANCE NO. 3-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO REPAIR THE ROOF AT THE CITY GARAGE THAT WAS DAMAGED FROM RECENT STORMS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the roof at the City Garage, located at 33 Park Drive, Port Clinton, was damaged by recent storms and is in need of immediate repair; and

Whereas, the City received a check from its insurance company in the amount of \$73,000 to go towards the repairs; and

Whereas, the cost of the balance of necessary repairs is estimated not to exceed an additional \$50,000.00; and

Whereas, Section 735.05 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that this Council can authorize the Safety Service Director to enter into a contract for work or purchase of supplies or materials without bidding for emergency cases.

Wherefore, be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, Ohio:

- Section 1. The Director of Safety Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for necessary and immediate repairs to the roof at the City Garage located at 33 Park Drive.
- Section 3. This Council finds and determines that this is an emergency and the repairs to the roof need to be made immediately without obtaining bids.
- Section 4. The funds necessary for the repairs not to exceed \$123,000.00 are hereby appropriated from the Water Fund and Street Maintenance and Repair Fund.
- Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- Section 6. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to repair the roof at the City Garage immediately, wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
