## ORDINANCE 22-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR PORTAGE PARK, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO EXECUTE A GRANTEE AWARD CONTRACT WITH THE PARK DISTRICT OF OTTAWA COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has adopted legislation in Resolution 22-2 agreeing to cooperate with the Park District of Ottawa County under the terms of the 2022 Parks and Trails Improvement Grant Program and authorizing the Director of Safety and Service and City Auditor to apply for funding assistance under the grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of replacing the aged playground equipment at Portage Park; and

WHEREAS, the City researched and identified an appropriate playground equipment set available to obtain the best price possible for the purchase of the necessary equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$15,000.00 reimbursement grant by the 2022 Parks and Trails Improvement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to expend \$70,000.00 for the purchase of the playground equipment for Portage Park.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT CLINTON, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

- Section 1. The Director of Safety Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with a Supplier for the purchase of the playground equipment set for Portage Park.
- Section 2. The Director of Safety Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Grantee Award Contract with the Park District of Ottawa County.
- Section 3. The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to make available from the General Fund a sum not to exceed \$70,000.00 to pay the cost of the playground equipment set for Portage Park.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to provide for the timely reimbursement of \$15,000.00 by the Park District of Ottawa County by completing the Grant Award Contract specifications before October 31, 2022, wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
