## ORDINANCE 30 - 22

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 717.03 OF CHAPTER 717 OF THE PORT CLINTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGULATING PEDDLERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Port Clinton has previously adopted regulations for Peddlers in the City of Port Clinton; and

WHEREAS, it is important to review the City's Codified Ordinances periodically to determine if any updates need to be made; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that Section 717.03 of Chapter 717 regulating Peddlers should be updated and amended.

**NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio:

**Section 1**. Existing Section 717.03 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 717.03 ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE

The Auditor is hereby authorized and empowered to issue such licenses or permits, upon the Applicant submitting the following:

- 1. Applicant shall submit a completed application to the Auditor at City Hall;
- 2. Applicant shall provide to the Auditor a valid Government Photo ID;
- 3. Applicant shall submit to the Auditor a completed Solicitor Certificate of Registration with the City of Port Clinton Department of Taxation;
- 4. Applicant shall complete a BCI/FBI Criminal Background Investigation; and
- 5. No license will be issued to any Applicant that has been convicted of the following offenses:
  - a. Rape
  - b. Sexual Battery
  - c. Corruption of a minor
  - d. Gross sexual imposition
  - e. Sexual imposition
  - f. Felony

Section 2. Existing Codified Ordinance sections 717.03 is hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** Each section and each part of each section of this Chapter of the Codified Ordinances is hereby declared to be an independent Section or part of a Section and, notwithstanding any other evidence of legislative intent, it is hereby declared that if such section or part of a section, or any provision thereof, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remaining sections or parts of sections and the application of such provision to any other person or circumstances, other than those as to which it is held invalid, shall not be affected thereby, and it is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that the other provisions of this Chapter of the Codified Ordinances would have been adopted independently of such Section, Sections, or parts of a Section so held to be invalid.

**Section 4.** This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in those actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that the new regulations for peddlers need to be effective immediately to guarantee all peddlers will be subject to background checks, **wherefore**, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
