

ORDINANCE NO. 35-22

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE OCTOBER 2022
REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE PORT CLINTON CODIFIED
ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Constitution requires that Ohio municipal ordinances comply with State law if they are an exercise of the Municipality's police powers;

WHEREAS, an updated Traffic and General Offenses Code as contained in the current replacement pages has been prepared for the Municipality;

WHEREAS, certain other provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the recodification, editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Port Clinton, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:

SECTION 2: That the following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law.

Traffic Code

- 337.10 Lights, Emblems, and Reflectors on Slow-Moving Vehicles, Farm Machinery, Agricultural Tractors, and Animal-Drawn Vehicles. (Amended)
- 337.16 Number of Lights; Limitations on Flashing, Oscillating or Rotating Lights. (Amended)

General Offenses Code

SECTION 3: That the complete text of the sections listed above are set forth in full in the October 2022 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A. The listing above of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of October 2022 Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law, and shall go into effect immediately.
