

ORDINANCE NO. 10-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONCESSIONS LICENSE AT WATERWORKS PARK WITH NORTH COAST BEACHFITTERS

WHEREAS, North Coast Beachfitters would like to set up a seasonal business in the parking lot of Waterworks Park that will provide visitors to Port Clinton City Beach with access to non-motorized water/beach recreation equipment and accessories; and

WHEREAS, North Coast Beachfitters will set up a 20' by 7' trailer in the parking lot of Waterworks Park, near the Lake Erie Love sign, and will rent/sell water/beach recreation equipment and accessories; and

WHEREAS, this seasonal business will attract visitors and residents to the City Beach and Port Clinton area businesses, provide employment opportunities for local residents, and will support the local business community and economy; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a license agreement with North Coast Beachfitters for the operation of concessions in the parking lot at Waterworks Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, County of Ottawa and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a license agreement with North Coast Beachfitters, for the operation of concessions in the parking lot of Waterworks Park, near the Lake Erie Love sign, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the license agreement on file in the office of the Director, subject to changes and modifications not materially adverse to the City and approved on behalf of the City by the Director, all of which shall be evidenced conclusively by his execution of the license agreement.

Section 2. The Director, the Auditor, the Treasurer, the Clerk of Council, the Director of Law, and other City officials, as appropriate, are each authorized and directed to take any and all such other actions, including execution and delivery of any further agreements or instruments as are necessary or appropriate to consummate the transaction contemplated by this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in those actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
