

RESOLUTION 23 - 4

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PORT CLINTON POLICE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT MODERNIZATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR CONGRESSIONALLY DIRECTED SPENDING TO THE HONORABLE MARCY KAPTUR AND THE HONORABLE SHERROD BROWN

WHEREAS, the United States Congress makes available Congressionally Directed Spending to local governments, educational institutions, and non-profit organizations through the Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act for U.S Department of Justice programs; and

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Safety and Service has identified needs that can be funded using the Congressionally Directed Spending available through such U.S Department of Justice programs; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Safety and Service intends to apply for funding for priority equipment and technology based on the needs of the City, provided for in the Police Department Equipment Modernization Project, enabling the Police Department to respond more quickly and effectively to public safety incidents in the community and region, including calls for mutual aid in neighboring jurisdictions, prevent crime, improve officer safety, and decrease operating costs of the department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Police Department Equipment Modernization Project is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit applications on/or by the application date for Congressionally Directed Spending, on behalf of the City, for the Police Department Equipment Modernization Project, along with all necessary supporting documentation, to the Honorable Marcy Kaptur, United States House of Representatives, and the Honorable Sherrod Brown, United States Senate.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions are in meeting open to the public in compliance with the law.
