A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AGREEMENT FOR BUCKEYE COMMUNNITY SEVENTY SIX LP, AN OHIO LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

WHEREAS, the Tax Incentive Review Board made a recommendation to this Council to authorize the continuation of the Community Reinvestment Area Agreement for Buckeye Community Seventy Six LP; and

WHEREAS, this Council agrees with the recommendation the Tax Incentive Review Board made.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio:

- **Section 1.** This Council finds that Buckeye Community Seventy Six LP is in compliance with the terms of its Community Reinvestment Agreement.
- **Section 2.** This Council authorizes the continuation of the Community Reinvestment Area Agreement #123-64150-168 for Buckeye Community Seventy Six LP, as recommended by the Tax Incentive Review Board.
- **Section 3.** This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions are in meeting open to the public in compliance with the law.
