- **Section 2.** This Council authorizes the continuation of the Community Reinvestment Area Agreement #123-64150-176 for RAR Hospitality, LLC, as recommended by the Tax Incentive Review Board.
- **Section 3.** This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions are in meeting open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
