

ORDINANCE NO. 25 - 23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (ODNR) TO OBTAIN NEW BUOYS THROUGH THE ODNR NAVIGATIONAL AIDS GRANT

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, County of Ottawa and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to apply for a Navigational Aids Grant with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) and to execute any agreements for and on behalf of the City of Port Clinton, with the State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources, thereby enabling the City to receive financial assistance through the Navigational Assistance Grant for the purchase of new buoys for the Port Clinton Police Department.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in those actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
