GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

QUALIFICATIONS: An example of acceptable qualifications:

Completion of secondary education, or equivalent, and experience demonstrating knowledge of and ability to handle heavy equipment, air and power tools, and hand tools; one (1) years' experience in general construction, street, water, or sewer maintenance and repairs, materials, and equipment; knowledge of laws and regulations governing motorized equipment operation, safety practices and procedures, and heavy equipment repair.

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- 25% (2) Operates heavy and complex motorized equipment to assist with the efficient delivery of city services (e.g., backhoe, grader, loader, asphalt distributer, roller, dump truck, sewer truck, tractor, welder, air compressor, generator, sweeper, hoists, etc.); installs, services, repairs, and replaces catch basins, sewer and water lines, driveways, curbs, sidewalks, etc. (e.g., cleans, removes, and repairs pipe, sets steel and wood forms, pours and finishes concrete, etc.); performs general maintenance and repair involving electrical, mechanical, plumbing, welding, and cutting operations; inspects equipment in order to ensure safe operation; does line locations.
